The meeting was called to order by Patricia Combs, Chairman, at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Patricia Combs, Jim Marsic, and Randy Peterson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a welcome given.

Ms. Combs asked if there were any comments, additions, or corrections to the March 5, 2024 minutes. Ms. Combs moved Mr. Marsic seconded the minutes as presented. At a call for vote: Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Two (2) jobs and the Department of Aging newsletter were posted.

Items were passed between each Trustee.

The following item was passed to Ms. Combs: OTARMA update.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Russ Nack, Penn Ohio, asked if his company's prices for clean-up day were reviewed.

Discussion ensued as to his prices and timing of his prices.

Ms. Combs moved Mr. Peterson seconded **RESOLUTION 2024-15** for the yearly appropriations. At a call for vote: Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

ZONING:

Mr. Benesh reported that the business permit for the Corner Store was received.

The Karnosh home was removed.

It was reported that Mr. Dombrowski has not been in contact with contractors regarding the removal of the home he owns.

Ms. Combs discussed a meeting she attended with Geauga Public Health present. She had a discussion with them and was told that properties can be checked on if the Township feels an environmental issue is present. Ms. Combs will contact Geauga Public Health with the address of the property concern.

ROAD DEPARTMENT:

RESOLUTION 2024-10 was read. Mr. Marsic moved Ms. Combs seconded **RESOLUTION 2024-10** to use the auction services of Mihalic Auctioneers. At a call for vote: Mr. Peterson AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE, Ms. Combs AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

RESOLUTION 2024-11 was read. Mr. Marsic moved Mr. Peterson seconded **RESOLUTION 2024-11** to sell the Case Loader at auction. At a call for vote: Mr. Marsic AYE, Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

RESOLUTION 2024-12 was read. Ms. Combs moved Mr. Peterson seconded **RESOLUTION 2024-12** to sell the crack-seal material at auction. At a call for vote: Mr. Peterson AYE, Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

RESOLUTION 2024-13 was read. Mr. Peterson moved Mr. Marsic seconded **RESOLUTION 2024-13** to sell the Montana tractor at auction. At a call for vote: Mr. Marsic Aye, Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

Discussion ensued as to selling of the x-mark mower. It was decided to not sell the mower.

RESOLUTION 2024-14 was VOIDED.

Mr. Marsic discussed the quote from Suite-Kote for crack-sealing and top coating the roads. Discussion ensued. Mr. Marsic moved Ms. Combs seconded to accept the quote from Suite-Kote for \$70,536.12 for road work during 2024.

Mr. Marsic stated he is looking at the next round of OPWC grants that Montville will be eligible to apply for. He would like to adjust the project to just be Kile Rd. in combination with Hambden Township in 2026.

The cold patch applied to Hart Rd. by Mr. Benesh is holding.

The road department was advised to watch the edge of the road by the Stanley home.

Burrows Rd. has not been discussed at the Thompson Trustee meeting as of today.

Sun Rd. needs to have material in the hole and have the maintainer pulled down. The "Rough Road" signs need to be posted.

HALL RENTALS:

No new rentals.

FEES COLLECTED:

None.

The up-coming social room rental will be offered the main hall at no price increase due to the roof leaking.

The 6/15 booking has not contacted Mr. Peterson or given a deposit.

An inquiry has come in to rent the Main Hall on 4/8. Discussion ensued. Mr. Marsic moved Mr. Peterson seconded to not rent the building on 4/8 for the eclipse. The parking lot and pavilion are open to the public. All members were in favor to close the building for 4/8/24.

CEMETERY:

1 new foundation request has been received.

The headstone for Mr. Hauser has been located. The delivery was found by Veterans Affairs in Washington DC pulling the freight ticket. It was signed for by a firefighter and placed in the bay of the road department. No mention of the delivery had been made to anyone.

PERSONNEL:

None.

OTHER:

Swing set quote was given verbally for a handicap swing. It could replace one of the child swings. A written quote broken down showing the materials and installation split apart will be asked for to allow for easier payments. The Company has asked for materials to be paid up-front. **RESOLUTION 2024-9** will be held until the costs are known.

Dishwasher is having problems.

Carpet in the Trustees meeting room is wet. Mr. Benesh will investigate more in the morning and call the HVAC repair if needed.

The insurance appraiser came out to look at the roof damage. It was deemed to be wind damage. The Township carries a \$500 deductible. Mr. Peterson moved Ms. Combs seconded to accept the insurance claim for \$15,459.74. At a call for vote: Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

Clean up day quotes were discussed. Mr. Marsic will contact Penn Ohio to see if they would like the tire part of clean-up day with the costs of \$250 per haul, \$205 per ton and no fuel charge and environmental charges.

Cotterman will still do the metal collection and trash.


Ms. Combs stated that she attended the Health Advisory Board and they voted on a new member.

A letter requesting support from the Ohio Senators for a grant to build a new fire station on the Rte. 6 property was discussed.


Purchase orders were signed.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INTENT TO DISPOSE OF UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE, OR UNFIT TOWNSHIP PERSONAL PROPERTY VIA INTERNET AUCTION FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024

Montville Township, Geauga County, Ohio

The Board of Trustees of Montville, Township, Geauga County, Ohio met in regular session on the ~~January~~ ^{19th} day of ~~January~~ ^{March} 2024 at the office of the Montville Township Trustees with the following members present:

Randal Peterson, James Marsic, Patricia Combs

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10 (D) requires a Board of Montville Township Trustees to adopt a resolution during each calendar year expressing its intent to dispose of surplus, unneeded, obsolete, or unfit personal property through the use of an internet auction;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Montville Township Trustees hereby expresses its intent to dispose of surplus, unneeded, obsolete, or unfit personal property by Internet-based Auction during the calendar year 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the personal property disposed of through the Internet-based Auction may include, as specified in ORC 505.10 (D), motor vehicles acquired for the use of Township officers and departments, road machinery, car parts, equipment, tools, and office equipment or supplies which are not needed, obsolete, or unfit for the public use for which it was acquired; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all property is offered for sale "as is, where is" with Montville Township making no warranty, guarantee, or representation of any kind expressed or implied, as to the condition of said items; and that any computers sold via Internet-based auction shall have their hard drive either wiped utilizing U.S. Department of Defense standards or the hard drive will be removed; and the Buyer will receive notification by e-mail from the Montville Township auction and be required to make payment in full via US currency, certified cashier's check, money order, or company check (with bank letter guaranteeing funds) within five (5) business days from the time and date of said notification; and the Buyer will be responsible for removal of said items from the Montville Township facility within ten (10) business days of receipt of said notification; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the number of days of bidding for each auction, in accordance with ORC 505.10 (D), will be at least fourteen (14) days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Montville Township Trustees shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation, notice of its intent to sell surplus, unneeded, obsolete, or unfit-for-use township personal property by internet-based auction to be published at least two weeks before the sale of the property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a similar notice shall also be posted continuously throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in the offices of the Board of Montville Township Trustees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any auction sale will be posted continuously on the Township website (www.Montvillegeauga.com); with a link to Mihalic Associates & Auctioneer, 11993 Ravenna Rd., Suite #4, Chardon, Oh 44024, Phone 440-285-7653; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that when property is to be sold by Internet-based Auction, the Board of Montville Township Trustees or its representatives reserve the right, to establish a minimum price that will be accepted for specific items and may establish any other terms and conditions for the particular sale, including but not limited to requirements for pick-up or delivery, method of payment, and payment of sales tax in accordance with applicable laws; and


