The meeting was called to order by Patricia Combs, Chairman, at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Patricia Combs, Jim Marsic, and Randy Peterson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a welcome given.

Ms. Combs asked if there were any comments, additions, or corrections to the January 7, 2025 minutes. Ms. Combs moved Mr. Marsic seconded to waive the reading of the minutes and accept the minutes as submitted. At a call for vote: Mr. Peterson AYE, Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

## CORRESPONDENCE:

One (1) job was posted.

Items were passed between each Trustee.

Items passed to Ms. Combs included: Grassroots, Letter from the County Recorder, NOPEC Energized Community Grant, Metzenbaum Center Newsletter, Zoning Commission minutes from November & December 2024, and Zoning Appeals minute from February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November and December 2024.

## **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Luann Burger stated that the Fire Association driveway can be plowed and used by the Township for cemetery business.

The Fire Association VFDF members for 2025 were elected and a list given to Mrs. Hawkins to submit.

## FISCAL OFFICER:

Ms. Hawkins asked for the following appropriation move:

Ms. Combs moved Mr. Marsic seconded the above appropriation move. At a call for vote: Mr. Marsic AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE, Ms. Combs AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

RESOLUTION 2025-5 for the NOPEC NEC Grant was read. Ms. Combs moved Mr. Peterson seconded RESOLUTION 2025-5. At a call for vote: Mr. Marsic AYE, Ms. Combs, Mr. Peterson AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

The NOPEC NEC Agreement was signed.

#### FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Chief Jonovich submitted a letter sent to Aiden Bock. He has never returned to the department after being approved to be on the Cadet program. His equipment and uniform was collected and a payment of \$82.00 was given to the department for pants not returned. Mr. Marsic moved Mr. Peterson seconded to removed Aiden Bock from the Cadet program.

A quote for tracks for the Argo was presented for \$2,800. These tracks can be removed and put on a new unit. A trade-in value has not been received. Ms. Combs moved Mr. Peterson seconded to purchase the tracks at a cost of \$2,800. At a call for vote: Ms. Combs AYE, Mr. Peterson AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

Four (4) computers (MTD's) were requested to be purchased. (3 of one type and 1 of another) at a total cost of \$18,740.21. Discussion ensued. These will go into the Chief's car, grass truck, tanker and engine. Ms. Combs moved Mr. Peterson seconded to purchase 4 computers for the vehicles at a cost of \$18,740.21. At a call for vote: Mr. Peterson AYE, Mr. Marsic AYE, Ms. Combs AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

#### PERSONNEL:

The Worker Comp. hearing date and time was given to Trustees and the Chief. ZONING:

Mr. Benesh stated that he has spoken to the owner of the Guitar Store. He will apply for a business permit and sign.

A call was received from a person interested in purchasing the "Old Action House". He is looking to open a business to sell farm equipment and rentals, plus golf carts.

The corner store is planning to open in February.

Mr. Marsic asked about progress with the Dombrowski property. This is the last of the items in the "Book". Mr. Peterson will contact Mr. Dombrowski.

A notice for ZBA and ZC looking for people to service on the Board will go into the Newsletter.

ROAD DEPARTMENT:

More grit material is needed. Mr. Marsic will order.

A meeting is being put together for discussion on Burrows Rd. with the Engineers and Thompson Trustees. Hold the date of February 25.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL (NOPEC) 2025 ENERGIZED COMMUNITY GRANT

WHEREAS, the Township of Montville, Ohio (the "GRANTEE") is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council ("NOPEC") and is eligible for one or more NOPEC Energized Community Grant(s) for 2025 ("NEC Grant(s)") as provided for in the NEC Grant Program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the GRANTEE wishes to enter into a Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc. in substantially the form presented to this Board of Trustees to receive one or more NEC Grant(s); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MONTVILLE TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF GEAUGA, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Board of Trustees of the GRANTEE (the "Board") finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the GRANTEE to enter into the Grant Agreement to accept the NEC Grant(s) for funds.

SECTION 2. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the GRANTEE; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the GRANTEE.
