Crack seal will need to be applied to Joann Rd., Whitney Rd., Burrows Rd. and Dewy Rd.. Joann Rd. needs work. With no crack seal applied in 2024, water has gotten under the road. Hart Rd. "A" is looking to be holding.

Expanding more to the east side of the "bays", adding storage in the new bay area, and changing the storage room to an exercise room was suggested. Scheduling another meeting with the Architects should be planned; however, the committee should review the drawing and bring any changes to the meeting.

NOPEC Community Grant was awarded for Community Day 2025 for \$1,000.

The contract for Risk Factor was signed without needing their workers comp.

Mrs. Hawkins explained that the new UAN computer and printer have been received and the transfer of information has begun. The old UAN computer will have all the files removed then the equipment, laptop and printer are a donation to the Township from the Auditor of State. Mrs. Hawkins suggested moving the old UAN computer (laptop) and printer to the zoning office, transferring the old desk top computer files to the laptop; then the desk top can be removed from service.

The office will need a few items to bring the office up to date. A cable to secure the laptop to the desk, a second monitor, and a wireless keyboard and mouse were discussed for purchase. Trustees were in favor of the purchases.

When all of the hardware is set up in the office the copier can be used by Mrs. Abrams for the zoning documents printing.

Ms. Combs explained that the CPF Grant with David Joyce's Office is open. The deadline is March 20. She asked for help in filing the grant for the fire addition or the park. Mr. Marsic stated he will send information for the park to Ms. Combs.
